	Zinfandel Santa Barbara County Kept in American Oak barrels for over 20 months			
2005	51 cases remaining as of November 2010 Vintage notes: Bottled in May 2007, this wine delivers the essence of Zin in all aspects. Constant summer temperatures allowed for uniform ripening of the grapes, developing into a wine that offers nuanced fruit characteristics. This vintage has the full, jammy essence of a Zinfandel with bottle time.	\$18	\$15	\$14
2006	90 cases remaining as of November 2010 Vintage notes: Bottled in June 2008, the higher than normal 2006 winter rainfall followed by a dry but not excessively hot summer produced concentrated dry-farmed grapes with excellent brix (sugars) at harvest. Full blackberry fruit characterizes this Zin tasting very mellow in the mouth.	\$14	\$12	\$11
2007	70 cases remaining as of November 2010 Vintage notes: Bottled in June 2009, this Zin is full bodied, with the fruit of raspberries being the most forward in the mouth. The first year of drought (only 4 inches of rain) and late frost caused a big drop in yields which produced smaller, more concentrated grapes. Drinks very nicely now, and will get even better with cellar time.	\$17	\$14	\$13
2008	115 cases produced. release date: June 2010 Vintage notes: Bottled in January 2010, this wine is full of black cherries and a touch of chocolate characteristic of a traditional dry-farmed Zin. The second year of drought (only 9 inches of rain) and late frost reduced yields as in 2007. Drinks well now. In several years it will take on the full jammy flavors of a classic "Big Zin".	\$18	\$15	\$14
	Shiraz Santa Barbara County Kept in American Oak barrels for over 20 months			
2006	42 cases remaining as of November 2010 Vintage notes: Bottled in May 2008, the ideal winter rainfall of 2006 and even ripening of the grapes brings out the smoky richness of plum and spice of a dry-farmed Shiraz. Enjoy this wine as it continues to deepen with more time in the bottle.	\$19	\$16	\$15
2008	48 cases produced. release date: June 2010 Vintage notes: Bottled in January 2010. The 2008 season was our second year of drought. Yields were very low, but the resulting quality of the grapes was high. Small fruit gave a high skin to juice ratio, leading to very concentrated flavors of plum and spice. Classic Shiraz smokey overtones fill the nose.	\$21	\$18	\$17

2009	Blended Desire 25 cases produced release date: July 2010 Vintage notes: This delicious blend of carignan, zinfandel, mourvèdre and mission grapes was crafted into a dry rosé in the European tradition. The delicate hint of strawberries adds a nice finish that will enhance your drinking pleasure. Enjoy well chilled!	\$13	\$11	\$10
	Our Mentor's Zinfandel Paso Robles Kept in American Oak barrels for over 20 months			
	Benito Dusi grew up on the ranch that he farms today just South of Paso Robles, California. He carefully tends Zinfandel vines grown in the traditional dry-farmed, head pruned style that he learned from his father. We met Ben when we began planting our vineyard in 1997. He became our mentor, teaching us these traditional techniques to use at Condor's Hope. We are very pleased to be one of the few small producers of wine from Benito Dusi's old vine Zinfandel.			
2006	20 cases remaining as of November 2010 Vintage notes: A perfect rainfall year produced higher yields of uniform grapes with excellent balance of old vine fruit. Enjoy now and put some of this full berry and spice wine in your cellar for your future enjoyment.	\$23	\$20	\$18
2007	59 cases remaining as of November 2010 Vintage notes: We continued the tradition of receiving grapes from our mentor's 85 year old vines to share with you the depth of old vine Zin grown using dry farmed traditional methods. This drought year will live up to all of our expectations of a full fruit, jammy "Big Zin".	\$21	\$18	\$17
2008	48 cases produced. release date: September 2010 Vintage notes: The second year of drought intensified this old vine Zin even more than usual, with cherries, chocolate, and spice all melding into one of the best Zins we have tasted.
